BROADCHALKE



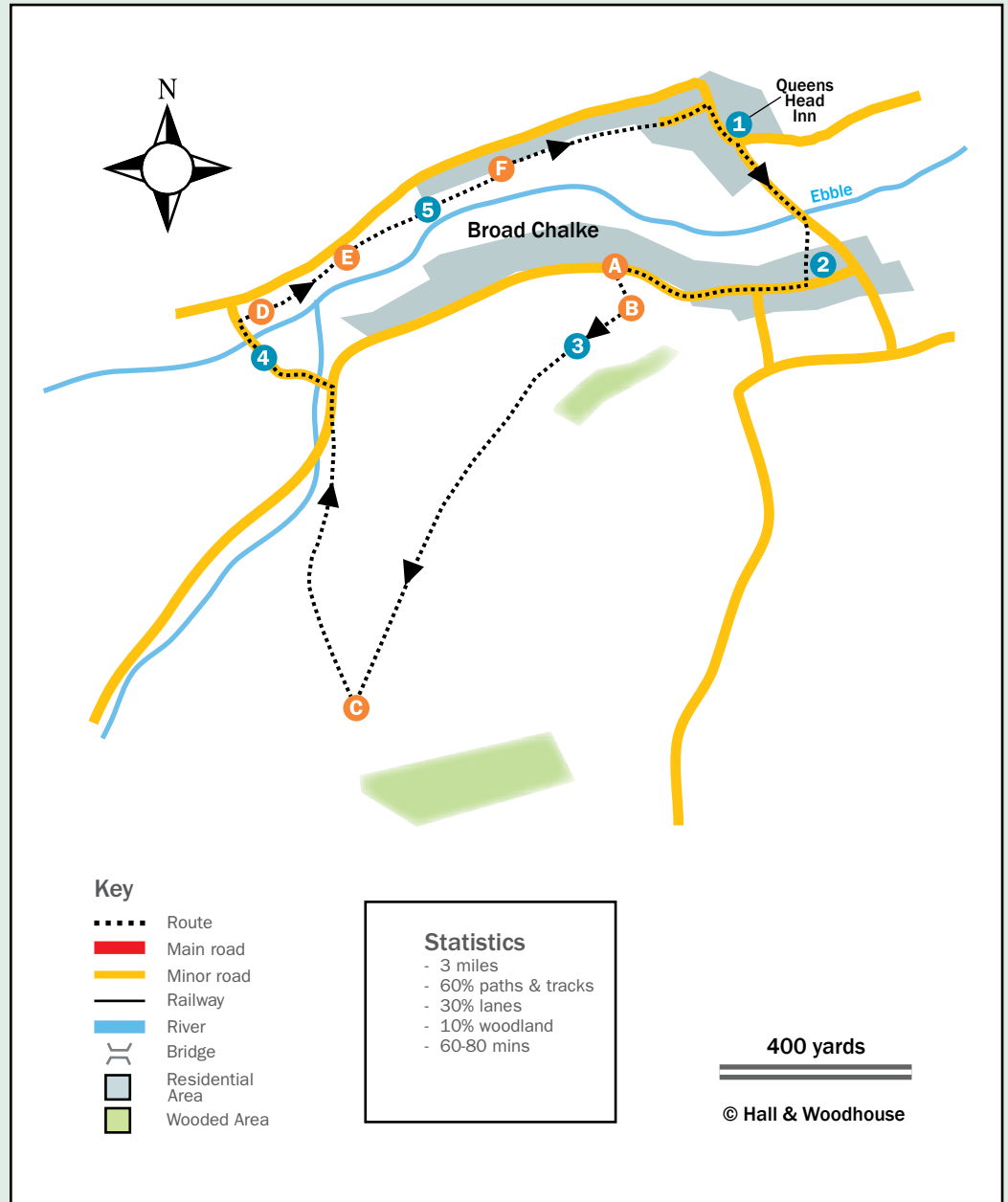

**1** From the pub, cross road and walk ahead into Doves Meadow opposite. After 200 yards, cross bridge and turn right on to footpath 15 yards on.

**2** Pass church to left and, with village hall ahead, turn right on to lane. Follow for 400 yards through the village past delightful old houses, pass shop to right and turn left 30 yards on at

**A** byway sign (see assist).

Head uphill on track for 100 yards and, with thatched wall to left, turn

**B** right (see assist). Follow

**3** uphill for 500 yards and path opens out with good downland views to left.

250 yards on, pass to left of metal gate and continue ahead for 500 yards. With large barn 250 yards ahead, turn right at 5 o'clock on to grass

**C** track (see assist).

Follow between open fields for 150 yards and pass through wood gate to right of metal gate. Continue on path downhill through trees for 400 yards and turn right on to

lane. Follow for 80 yards with stream to left and turn left into lane past small post box.

**4** 100 yards on, lane bends left with thatched cottage on right. Walk past cress beds, head uphill for 50 yards and turn right at the footpath sign. Pass through wood gate and past farm house on gravel track.

**D** After 40 yards, continue ahead on grass path (see assist) and, 40 yards on, pas through wood gate. Follow track for 100 yards and on to tarmac drive. Just pass car ports to left,

**E** bear right on to path (see assist) and head gently downhill.

**5** Continue on track with trees and stream to right. Pass through wood kissing gate and follow path aiming just to right of brick house 350 yards ahead.

Walk through metal kissing gate and on to narrow path, past house to left. Ahead, ignore path to right and bear left (see assist).

**F**

Follow past houses to left and, 120 yards on, allotments to right. Continue ahead on to made up track past barns and cottages for 150 yards.

Pass post box to left and turn right on to road. Follow round for 120 yards back to the pub for some much deserved hospitality!
