



# Public House Walks

## The Rose & Crown

LANGBURTON



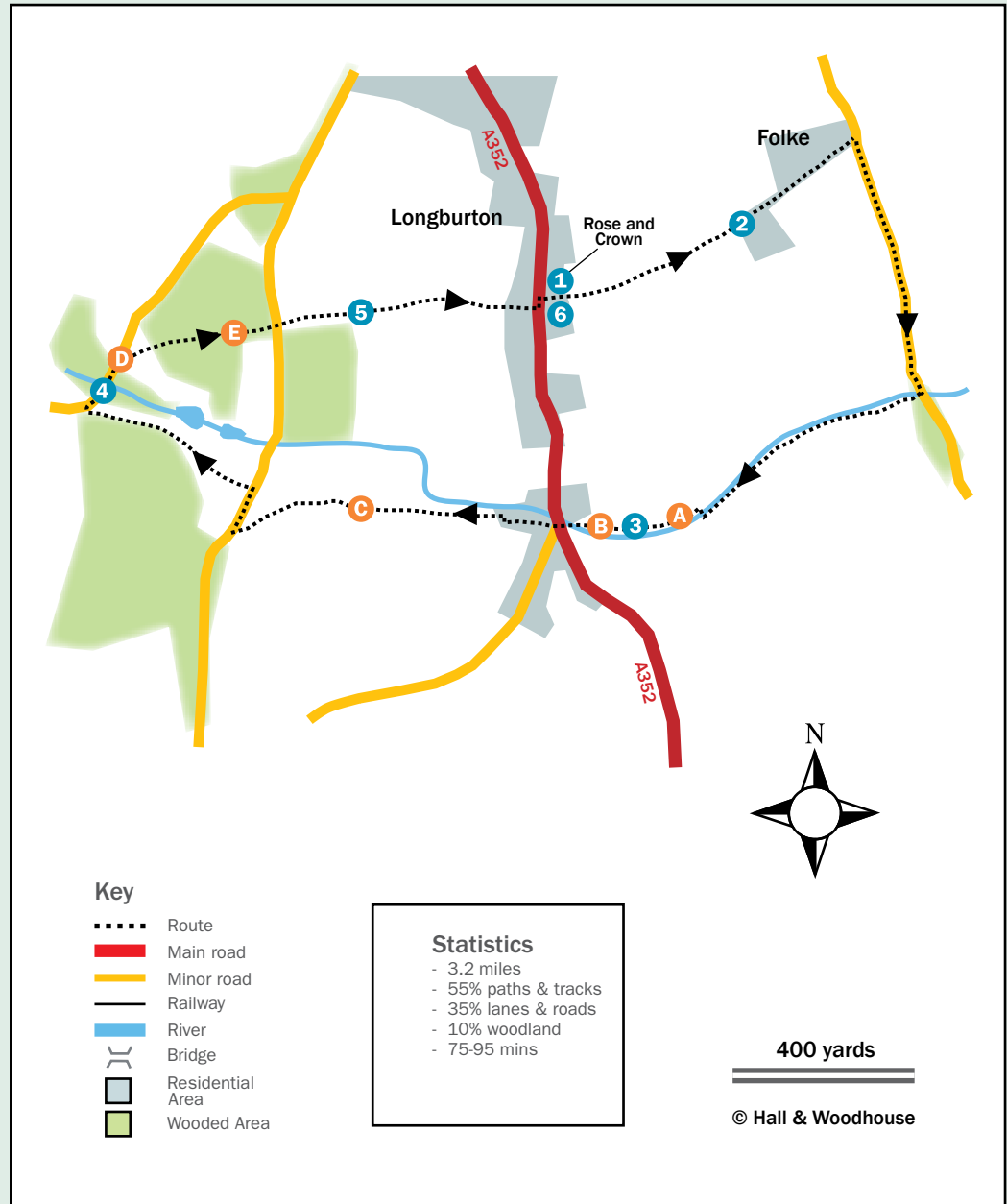
*"A varied, interesting and gently undulating walk that includes open fields, peaceful lanes, wooded paths and orchards. Lots to see and enjoy."*

- 1** From the pub, turn left and immediately left again. Follow drive ahead past church to right and between open fields. 400 yards on, pass wall and conifers to right, cross stream and pass West Hall to right.

Walk gently uphill past farm and metal gate. Continue for 150 yards and turn right on to lane ahead. Head gently downhill past trees and ivy banks. After 400 yards, lane opens out. Follow for 250 yards, cross bridge and turn right on to track.

50 yards on, pass through metal gate and walk along right edge of field with fence and stream to right. After 600 yards, pass through metal gate and continue along right edge. 120 yards on, pass through metal gate and follow path through trees.

With plant to left, turn right and cross wood foot bridge. Turn left and follow left edge of field for 40 yards. In field corner bear left (see assist) and follow path over wall into next field.

- 3** Continue along left edge of field for 300 yards with stream and trees to left. As field curves to right, bear left (on to path see assist) and cross stream (over stones).

Follow path through trees for 50 yards and cross main road (with care) into Bradford Lane opposite. 25 yards ahead, turn right at brideway sign and pass through wood gate on to made up track.

60 yards on, pass through metal gate on to grass track. 40 yards ahead, turn right through wood gate (to right of two metal gates). After 30 yards, path bends left. Follow past fields to left and trees to right.

250 yards ahead, pass through metal gate on to path (may be soft underfoot). After 100 yards, pass through metal gate and walk ahead keeping to right edge of field (see assist). 150 yards on, pass through metal gate on to track and then wood gate. After 80 yards, turn right and follow lane for 80 yards.

Turn left at brideway sign and follow tarmac track for 60 yards. Walk ahead past barn to left and track becomes a path. 80 yards on, pass to left of metal gate and continue ahead through trees for 150 yards.

Turn right at lane junction and head gently downhill.

- 4** Cross bridge and, 50 yards on, turn right through metal kissing gate (see assist). Follow path through saplings for 60 yards, pass marker and continue ahead gently uphill through orchard.

After 200 yards, bear left on to track and then right 10 yards on (see assist). Walk through trees and 20 yards on, ignore fork to left. 60 yards ahead, cross lane, walk up steps and pass through metal kissing gate.

Walk ahead with fence to left and orchard to right. 200 yards on, continue on path between fences. Pass through metal kissing gate and head straight on just to left of telegraph poles for 100 yards. Pass through metal



- 6** kissing gate. 20 yards on, cross stile and continue on track. Cross another stile and turn left on to road past the church. It's just 50 yards back to the pub for some well earned hospitality!
